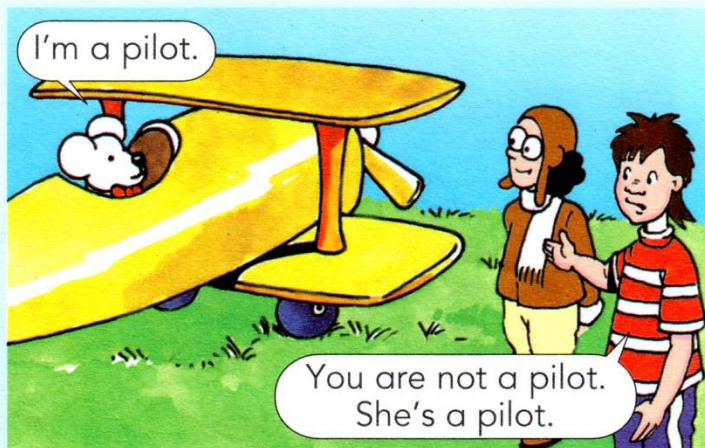

Am I?

Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.

Are you?

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.

Is he?

Yes, he is. / No, he isn't.

Is she?

Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.

Is it?

Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.

Are we?

Yes, you are. / No, you aren't.

Are you?

Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.

Are they?

Yes, they are. / No, they aren't.

- ☞ Употребяваме **he** за мъже и момчета, **she** за жени и момичета, **it** за животни, растения и предмети, а в множествено число за всички употребяваме **they**.

- ☞ Вместо пълната форма можем да употребим кратката форма, например: кратката форма на **I am** е **I'm**, на **you are** е **you're**.
- ☞ За да зададем въпрос, поставяме глагола (**am, are, is**) отпреди, например: **I am** -> **Am I?** **You are** -> **Are you?**
- ☞ За образуване на отрицателната форма добавяме **not** след **am, are** или **is**, например:
I am not a pilot. **You are not a pilot.**
Кратките форми са: **I'm not** и **you aren't**.
I'm not a pilot. **You aren't a pilot.**
- ☞ За да отговорим отрицателно на въпрос, можем да употребим кратката форма:
Is he a pilot? No, he isn't.
Но когато отговаряме положително, не употребяваме краткия отговор:
Is she a pilot? Yes, she is. ~~Yes, she's.~~
- ☞ **She is a pilot.** **They are** ~~a~~ **pilots.**
